

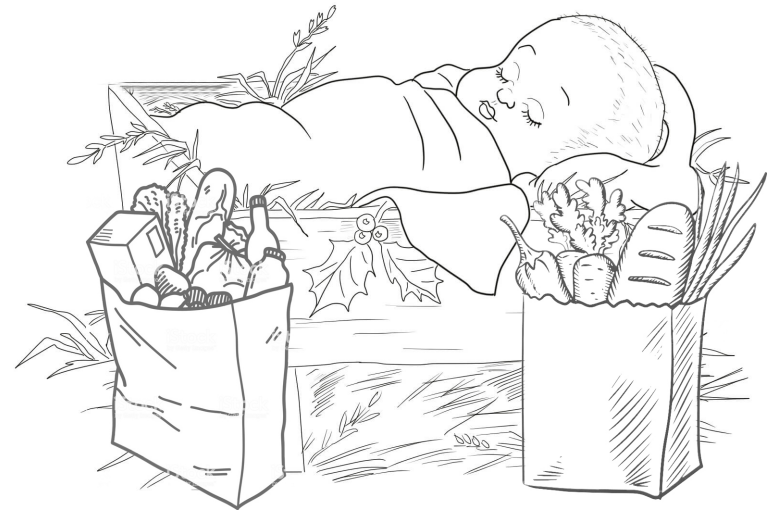
How does the Reverse Calendar Work?

The Reverse Advent Calendar is a really simple idea and a great way to be involved in our community.

Simply pick out a sturdy basket, box or better still a grocery bag and fill it with donations from the list provided below – one item for every day for 21 days. Then, when your bags are filled, bring them to church on December 23rd. A bible verse is provided for each item.

The beauty of a Reverse Advent Calendar is in its simplicity but also in how it can be customized. You can add one item a day or purchase several items every time you shop.

You can collect the items from your whole family/coworkers or from each member in your family/co-workers.
