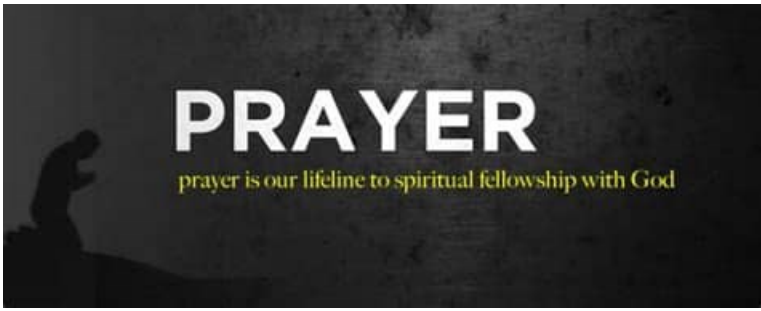
BENEDICTION
